# Power Units may Miss Closing Coal Stock Target as Heat Soars

New Delhi: An unusually warm February, coupled with industrial consumption, may lead to less-than-expected coal stock at power plants, raising concerns over meeting fuel de-

mand in the summer months. February and March, being the last two months of the financial year, are usually when incremental coal stocks build up at power plants, which helps in meeting fuel supply in

the summer months. The IMD has forecast above normal maximum temperature in some

parts in the coming summer. While the current coal stocks at plants are higher than a year ago, there has been minimal increase in February and in so far March, which was not anticipated, a senior government official said.

The coal ministry had aimed for 45

March end, As of March 8, total stock at plants was at 33,7 million tonnes.
